 More Information on How it All Works

At the Crazy H Farm we are committed to growing our produce as naturally as possible. While our farm is not certified organic, we use organic methods to grow our vegetables and fruit.

- Each weekly CSA share will contain an assortment of at least five different produce types.
- CSA shares extend over a period of eight weeks from mid-June through mid-August. At the end of eight weeks depending on weather and produce availability we will be offering another four week extension for those of you who are interested in more produce later in the season.
- An online (email)order form will be sent out weekly throughout the season with a list of produce available for that weeks CSA share. You will be able to check off which vegetables you would like, and email the form back to Crazy H Farm at least 48 hours before pickup. If you do not fill out the form we will make up the order for you.
- Orders are made up of \$18 and \$25 dollar amounts. Prices for produce will be set according to the NH Market Bulletin.
- Please call at least 48 hours in advance if you will not be able to receive your order. You will be allowed to make up one missed share at the end of the eight weeks.
